A brief History

The Valley Funeral Home Chapel stands on what was the site of the Humston Baptist Church. The land for the church was given by the N.Q Humston and his wife to the Trustees of the Humston Baptist Church on August 27, 1904.

Rev. John Massie, who purchased the Grandstaff house in Edinburg in 1902, was an ordained Baptist Minister who received his Master's degree from Dennison College and attended Crozier Baptist Seminary. He was responsible for the building of the church which was named after the donors of the land who lived close by. The name of the church was later changed by Change of Name Certificate to the Valley Baptist Church on November 4, 1970.
