A brief History

Originally organized in 1996 as the Fort Valley Christian Outreach Church, this small community church grew rapidly in its early years. Church members refurbished their Sunday school area and added a large sanctuary in 2000-2001; a steeple and new signage were constructed in 2010. After a period of leadership difficulties around the turn of the century, the Rev. Jennings B. Wood became the new pastor in 2004. Under his leadership, the name was changed to the Kings Crossing Community Church of God. The congregation voted to become nondenominational and to focus on a program of strong

support for local and foreign mission projects.

Today, the congregation supports churches in India, Tanzania, the Caribbean, Guatemala, and the Philippines, as well as giving aid to a variety of Shenandoah County charitable organizations. In autumn 2012, the Community Church began to share its facility with the *Growing Tree*, a Christian school which offers early education and tutoring programs.
