A brief History

In 1881 Cornelius Zirkle saw a need for his daughter to have a place to worship and develop a deeper relationship with God. Therefore, in 1881, Mr Zirkle donated lumber for a church in Quicksburg for his daughter Polly Anne. Mr Sam Neff donated the land for the church. Mr Sam Jones, from Hawkinstown, Virginia, with aid of some local people, built the church. The church became the Quicksburg Methodist Episcopal South, then in 1939, it was renamed the Quicksburg Methodist, and later in 1968, the Quicksburg United Methodist Church because of a merger between the Methodist Churches and the Evangelical United Brethren Church.

Important dates in the church history:

- 1881 The first pastor was Rev. H.W.Kinzer
- 1924 The choir loft was built
- 1968 Basement was dug out for social hall and Sunday School rooms and a vestibule was built on.
- 1969 Furnace was donated to replace oil stoves
- 1977 Church was remodeled and new pews installed
- 1986 Siding on church
- 2005 Handicap ramp added to side of church
- 2006 Air conditioner and electric updated
- 2007 New roof put on
- 2007 Parking lot repaired

Throughout its history, the Quicksburg United Methodist Church has continually improved itself in order to become better equipped to minister to the needs of the surrounding community and to be a mission to the world at large.
